Gamification	Game-based Learning
 Adding Game Inspired Elements to Your Course	 Using Games to Meet Learning Outcomes
 Applying Game Mechanics to a non-game environment to encourage behavior	 The Learning Comes from Playing the Game
 Typically Incorporates Badges, Awards, Achievements	 Can be Accomplished Using Commercial (AAA) or Education Oriented Games
 Experience Points (XP) may be Used as Substitute for Traditional Grades	 Promotes Critical Thinking and Problem Solving
 Adding Game Inspired Elements to Your Course	 Can be Accomplished With Digital or Non-Digital Games
 Could Provide Students with Choice in Learning Path	 Might Involve Simulations to Allow Students to Experience the Learning
